Horace Adams Seibert, 89, of Pilesgrove passed away on October 29, 2024. Born in Bridgeton on October 16, 1935, Horace was the son of Franklin B. and Mamie Robinson Seibert.

Horace graduated from Salem High School in 1954 and took a job working for Salem County Farm. In 1956, Horace began working at his Uncle Delbert Robinson's farm equipment store in Elmer and in September 1958, shortly before his 23rd birthday, Horace was hired to manage the Swedesboro Feed Store.

By 1961, he was managing a profitable business in Swedesboro by day and building a house for his family on East Lake Road by night. In 1964, Horace was hired to manage Woodstown Ice and Coal, a business that he grew, diversified, and eventually owned before selling the business and retiring in 2000.

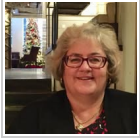
As a member of the First Baptist Church of Woodstown, Horace shared his business and leadership skills in a number of capacities, including as a Trustee, serving as President of the Board of Trustees for many years. He also served on the Pilesgrove Township Planning Board, but his enduring service to his community was to support the work of the Snelbaker Home, where he served as President of the Board for nearly 40 years.

He is survived by his wife of 14 years, Lois (nee: Sparks); his children, Anne Hudson and Horace Alan Seibert and his wife Michele and five grandchildren, Cameron Hudson (Laurel), Andrew Hudson (Chelsey), Chandler, Logan and Tyler Seibert and many nieces, nephews and cousins. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his first wife of 51 years Harriet and four siblings, Franklin Seibert, Gladys Goslin, Doris Jones and Wilson Seibert.
