Howard M. Foxwell, Jr, 90, of Carneys Point went to be with the lord on October 6, 2023. Born in Salem, Howard was the son of Howard M. Sr. & Martha Traini Foxwell. After graduating from Penns Grove Regional High School in 1952, he went on to work for and eventually retire from the US Postal Service after thirty-six years as a postal carrier. All who he delivered mail to, would better know him as “Foxy.” Growing up catholic, he received all of his sacraments through St. James RC Church and continued to serve and be faithful as the parishes merged and became The Parish of St. Gabriel the Archangel. Howard was a member of the Washington Club and the Senior Saints. Howard loved listening to music, he was a huge Philadelphia Eagles and Phillies fan. He would watch his “teams” on the tv but turn down the volume and listen to it announced on the radio. He always enjoyed plays at the Pitman theatre and taking bus trips with friends. Most importantly, his favorite time spent was with his family. He volunteered extensively, whether it was at the church or at events that were taking place in the community. Howard was always involved and loved to give back. He even played Santa Claus at the Elks Lodge and the Washington Club, to which his own grandchildren would sit on his lap, and not know it was “Pop Pop.” He will always be remembered by all who knew and loved him as the man with the signature mustache, his name on his belt buckle and that contagious beautiful smile. Howard was one of a kind, and an extraordinary man.
