Howard L. Williams, age 92, of Monroeville, passed away peacefully at his home on Friday, October 30, 2015. Born in Mantua, he was the son of the late George W. and Millicent A. (nee Wacker) Williams. Mr. Williams was a U.S. Army Veteran of World War II and saw active duty in France, Luxembourg, Belgium, Austria and Germany with the 101st Combat Engineer Battalion. He was a veteran of the "Battle of the Bulge" and was a lifetime member of the Battle of the Bulge Association, and also a member of the Yankee Division Veteran Association. Mr. Williams was employed for thirty six and a half years at the Mobil Oil Corp. in Paulsboro and lived in the Monroeville area since 1948. In addition, he was the owner/operator of a retail store, Country Supply from 1953-1970. He was a past member of the Elmer Ambulance Corps and the Monroeville Fire Department.

He is survived by his wife of sixty seven and a half years, Reba May (Maizie) LeSturgeon Williams; two sons, Howard Wesley and his wife Barbara J. and Edward L. of Monroeville; one daughter, Margo D.
