He also participated in Track & Field and had won first place in NJ SkillsUSA for motor controls. Through a lot of hard and diligent work, he was also able to achieve the distinction of becoming an Eagle Scout. After graduating from the Salem County Vocational Technical High School in 2015, Ian would join the U.S. Air Force. Since joining the Air Force Ian had been stationed at Whiteman Air Force Base in Knob Noster, Missouri as an aircraft mechanic. While in Missouri he participated as a volunteer leader with a local Boy Scout troop.
