On Monday, July 8, 2024, Jaci Bobbitt (nee Allen), formerly of Shady Lane Farm in Mannington, NJ died at the age of 95 at Merion Gardens in Carneys Point, New Jersey. Jaci was born in Portsmouth, Ohio to Hugh and Mary Ann (McCulley) Allen. She attended Marietta College in Ohio and then transferred to West Virginia University, where she met her husband, John.

Jaci was fiercely independent and espoused a bold and spirited personality, which was often apparent in her stylishly bright and sparkly, but classy attire. She always had a full social calendar between her many activities and spending time with her friends and loved ones. Jaci was a vibrant person with a passion for Arabian horses, having raised many on the family farm and traveled around the country to participate in horse shows. She was a terrific dancer of jitter bug, fox trot and waltz with her husband with whom she shared a passion for music. She loved the hot weather, vacationing at the beach and visiting Arizona. Jaci also enjoyed participating in the car business as she had an opportunity to select and drive different cars with her favorites being the Purple Barracuda and the teal Plymouth Satellite with a flowered vinyl roof.

She was an active member and volunteer in many community organizations, such as the Auxiliary Vice President and Chairperson of the Candy Striper Committee at the Memorial Hospital of Salem County, former member of the Mannington Township School Board of Education, 4-H Leader for eight years

where she led in winning two County and State Horse Bowl Championships, Charter Member and Secretary of Boots and Saddles Riding Club, member of the Mid-Atlantic Arabian Horse Association, member of the New Jersey Arabian Horse Club, and Manager of the Mid-Atlantic Arabian Horse Show Association at the Atlantic City Race Track for 4 years. In addition, Jaci was dedicated to bettering her local community through her participation as a member of the Board of Directors of the Salem County Veterans Administration, volunteer and supporter at Ranch Hope, volunteer leader in the Salem County Fair Association where she organized the Opening Exercises for nearly 20 years and helped in the food booth. She was also a member of the Salem Marketing and Promotion Committee of the Salem Main Street Project, volunteer in organizing the Salem Community College Foundation Gala, member of the Salem City Walking Ghost Tour Planning Committee, and member of the Salem City Yuletide Tour of Historic Homes Planning Committee.

Jaci received commendations for her dedication and involvement in Salem County including the Woman of Achievement Award given by the Salem County Commission on Women in 2017 and the prestigious Crystal Rose Award from the Salem County Chamber of Commerce in 2016.

A long-time member of Trinity United Methodist Church in Pennsville, New Jersey, Jaci participated on many of the Church's committees and nurtured, studied and grew in her faith daily.

Jaci is survived by her son, John, and daughter, Marianne; Grandchildren, Tiffany A. Miller (Hal), Sgt. Andrew J. Hart (Patricia), Catherine E. Bobbitt, Phillip A. Bobbitt, Michael A. Wooleyhand (Alicia) and Kylie K. Bobbitt as well as three great grandchildren, Branson, Michael Jr. and Lucas. She was predeceased by her parents, her husband John and four siblings, FeBoy Allen, Robert Allen, Nancy DuPey and Mary Belle Allen.

Services shall be held on Thursday, July 18, 2024 at Trinity United Methodist Church in Pennsville, New Jersey. The visitation will commence at 9:30AM with the memorial service at 11:00AM. In lieu of flowers, the family has requested donations be sent to the Salem County Veterans Administration. w
