James M. Eyer, age 86, of Elmer, passed away on July 5, 2020. Born November 3, 1933 at the Presbyterian Hospital in Philadelphia, he was the son of the late Robert Eyer Sr. and Sarah R. (Schumaker) Eyer. He was predeceased by his brother Robert Jr. as well as his baby sister Dorothy. James attended the old Elmer School where the Boro Hall is now and Bridgeton High School. Halfway through his apprenticeship in Blueprint Design, he was drafted into the United States Army where he served from 1956 to 1958. During his childhood, he attended Elmer Presbyterian Church.

In 1959, James started working as a mold maker for Anchor Hocking Glass in Salem and took an early retirement in 1992. He was proud of his 1953 Green Chevy Bel Air and his 1991 Red GMC. James enjoyed fishing with worms, looking for Native American artifacts, Colonial items, especially firearms and going to the Elmer Auction every Saturday. His true passion was feeding the furry squirrels and birds which he began doing in 1960.
