Our beloved dad and pop pop, James Giordano, of Carneys Point, NJ, passed away on January 23rd, 2024 at the age of 74. Predeceased by his parents Ralph and Eleanor Giordano (nee: Cona), Jimmy graduated from Penns Grove High School, Class of 1968. He was employed at Mannington Mills, in Mannington, NJ working for decades in the Installation Unit, retiring in 2012 after 39 years of dedicated service. A talented musician and former member of the American Federation of Musicians Local 595, Jimmy was well-known for the smooth sound of his Buescher 400 tenor saxophone, and having entertained many an audience with various bands throughout his life. Most recently, he was a member of Back@It, and he and his bandmates would regularly perform at DiPaolo's Ristorante in Penns Grove, NJ. Jimmy was the consummate renaissance man. Always curious and thirsty for knowledge, he was the go-to within the family whenever anything needed repairing, replacing, or constructing as his resourcefulness was second only to his desire to solve the problem before him. 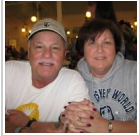
