James S. Wiley, Jr., 83, originally from Westville but spending the majority of his life in Elk Township, passed away on July 4, 2013. The son of the late James and Florence Wiley, Jim would proudly serve his country by entering the United States Army in 1946, would go on to serve in the United States Navy, and would return to the Army where he would retire in 1969 having accumulated 21 years of service. Mr. Wiley's career after service would find him in several different occupations in several different places. He worked boiler maintenance at Columbia Records / Sony, worked sales at Farm Rite in Shiloh, was a security guard at the Coastal Refinery and worked security for the senior care center in West Deptford, was a bus driver for the Friends School, a pit crew steward at the Atlantic City Speedway, and was custodian for the Elmer Presbyterian Church where he was a devoted member. Mr. Wiley served on the Elk Township Committee and also spent 30 years as a member of the Pitman Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons.
