James W. Zee III, 68, of Elmer passed away on September 21, 2024. Born in Woodbury and raised in Sewell, NJ, Jim was the son of James W. Zee Jr. and Jean Richardson. He was immensely proud to be working as the Corporate Safety Director with System One (formerly Joule') for the past forty-two years. Blessed with the gift of gab and having a natural talent for public speaking, his political career started in the early 1990's when he was elected to the Elmer School Board. After spending ten years on the board, his ambitions and desire to serve the community of Elmer led him to hold a seat on the Elmer Boro Council. He has continued to serve the people of Elmer as a councilman and municipal leader for over twenty-five years. In addition, Jim has been a member of the League of Municipalities for Salem County, the South Jersey Economic Development Board, the Salem County Planning Board and served as an officer of the Municipal Ambulance Board. He was also a member of the Elmer Republican Club representing the town at local and regional events as well as serving on the HOA of Heron Pond in Myrtle Beach, SC.

Jimi was an avid music lover. He attended many concerts, most recently the Bonamassa Blues Cruise and the Carolina Country Music Fest. He was a devout guitar enthusiast, holding a deep rooted passion for playing and collecting since his teenage years. established his own business, “Jimi’s Mouse House” where he raised and sold mice to local pet stores. He loved to travel the world with his wife by his side; some of their most memorable trips being Egypt, Micronesia, Thailand, Vietnam, Peru, Cambodia and Costa Rica. They also attended the forty-fifth Star Trek convention in Las Vegas where they met William Shatner, AKA, Captain Kirk. It should also be mentioned that Jim was extremely passionate about food enjoying all types of cuisines but his favorites were the home-cooked meals Ginny prepared each evening. When not in his beloved town of Elmer, he enjoyed spending time with his wife and family in their second home in Myrtle Beach, lovingly referred to by family as the “Zee House Tree House”.
