Janet Mae Munyan, 92, passed away on July 12, 2022. Born in Philadelphia, Janet was the daughter of John & Eleanor Robinson Schoch. She graduated from Paulsboro High School in 1949 and went on to work at the Mater Dei Nursing Home for thirty plus years. Over the years she was extremely active with the First Wesleyan Church in Vineland. She served as the church secretary, oversaw the missions, and taught Sunday School.
