Jean L. Figlio, 81, of Upper Pittsgrove died on April 6, 2010. Born in Hazleton, PA, Mrs. Figlio was the daughter of George & Genevieve Wilmot. She earned her degree from Smith College. Later she worked at the Carnegie Foundation for International Peace in New York, and at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia. Jean retired from Gloucester County Special Services School District where she assisted a program providing education to migrant farm worker's families. She was a gourmet chef, a master gardener, an avid reader, a lover of the arts, a potter, and an independent thinker.

She is survived by her daughter, Sarah Figlio and her son-in-law Eric Vander Arend of Chicago, IL, her son, Nathan Figlio and his wife Barbara of Pittsgrove, NJ, her son Lambert Bodeewes of Dallas, TX, a sister, Mary Hook of Silver Spring, MD and four grandchildren. She was predeceased by her husband Robert Figlio, her daughter, Meagan Figlio, and a sister Sally Stevens.
