For about a year it was my daily responsibility to help her to improve her already reasonable level of French. Quiet and cheerful, I could see that she was a patient, hard worker, devoted to her family. She continually advanced into a proficient and accurate speaker and writer - as far as I could tell, not being a native French speaker myself!

She was a tremendous pillar of strength for Ed, and a very devoted mother for Anna. They moved on into serving the missionary community there Senegal for many, many years, mostly in the realm of buying supplies, and doing the accounting necessary for that. Ed was always so cheerful, and he delighted in helping other people; he was a real servant to us! Jeannine always stood behind him, helping, encouraging and supporting in every way. In some ways therefore, Jeannine could be described as a servant's servant. Surely she has by now heard the great "Well done!" from her Lord Jesus Christ, and he has given her a high place in heaven because of her amazing servant's attitude as she served his other servants.
