Jennie Carina Bryszewski Adler, 50, currently residing in Pennsville, passed away on Monday, November 1, 2021. Born in Camden, Jennie grew up in National Park and formerly lived in Pittsgrove for 20 years. She was the daughter of Edward Bryszewski, Sr. and Jennie Clara Salustri Bryszewski. Jennie was a 1989 graduate of Gloucester Catholic High School and earned her Bachelors Degree in Child Psychology from Thomas Edison State University. She worked as a child psychologist at Southern New Jersey Perinatal Cooperative in Pennsauken and served as a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) for children. Jennie attended St. Mary's R.C. Church in Rosenhayn. She enjoyed cooking and canning, going to the beach and going to different breweries. Jennie loved all of her crazy friends and her dog Sadie. But, most of all, she truly loved her kids.

Jennie is survived by her mother Jennie Bryszewski; her loving husband Thomas Adler; her children Nicholas Nelson of Jersey City, Paige Nelson of Elmer and Horace Nelson III of Elmer; her siblings Debra Glover of Mt. 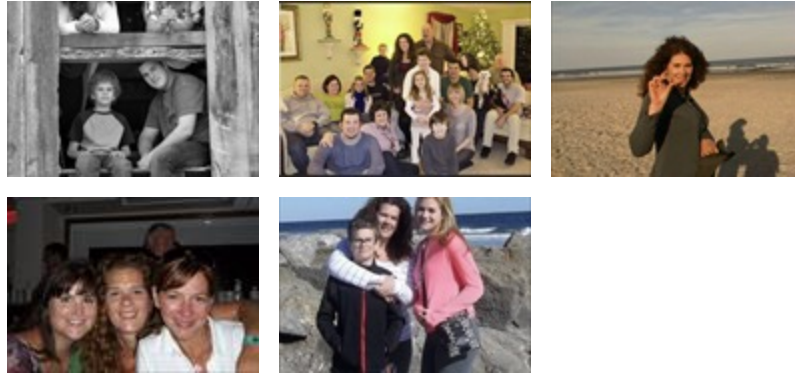
