Surrounded by his family and with the hand of God upon him, John W. Bobbitt, age 85, of Salem NJ, passed away on March 26th 2014. Born in Hopewell VA, Mr. Bobbitt was the son of Gollar F. and Sophie (Ham) Bobbitt. After graduating Penns Grove high school Mr. Bobbitt attended The University of West Virginia. During his time there, he would letter in three different sports which included football, baseball, and wrestling. After college he went on to join the Air Force and serve his country during the Korean War. Along with his brother Jack, the pair opened Bobbitt Auto in Penns Grove. Later they would move the business to Salem; however their commitment to quality service remained the same. It is estimated that over the years John and Jack sold over 25,000 vehicles, but the most important thing to them was the strong relationships that they had established with so many customers.

Throughout John's life the most important things to him were his relationship with the Lord, his family, his love of music, and his horses. Over the years John not only continued to build his relationship with God, but he was never afraid to speak and sing about God's Word. John was known throughout the region for his kindness and his commitment to God. Alongside his brother Jack, the two hosted Tuesday evening Bible Study which was held at the Dealership for over 35 years. In addition, he was known for his ministry as the lead singer in a Blue Grass Gospel group "The Kings Countrymen". Many lives have been touched over the years through these beloved ministries. He also attended Trinity Methodist Church in Pennsville where he was a longtime

member of the choir. Without question, the love and relationships John had with his family and friends was something very dear to his heart. He cherished every moment he had with all of them. John adored his wife Jaci, whom he met while on campus in West Virginia and spent 63 wonderful years with her. He loved spending time with his children and grandchildren whom he was known as "Poppop Bobbitt".

John is survived by his wife Jacquelyn "Jaci", son John and wife Jennifer, daughter Marianne, and grandchildren Tiffany A. Mallory, PVT Andrew J. Hart, Catherine E. Bobbitt, Phillip A. Bobbitt, Michael A. Wooleyhand, and Kylie K. Bobbitt. In addition to his parents, siblings Dallas "Jack" Bobbitt, G.V. Bobbitt, Leonard Wilson, Virginia Bliss, and Viola Myers predeceased him.
