John Paul Warner, Jr. 86, of Woodstown passed away on September 30, 2010. Born in Chambersburg, PA, Mr. Warner was the son of John P., Sr. & Mary A. Warner. He graduated from Anacostia High School in Washington, DC and then graduated from the Wharton Evening School. While in high school, he also did an internship as a machinist at the Navy Yard in DC. After serving in the U.S. Navy aboard the USS LCS(L)(3) 114 during the Second World War as a Radioman First Class, he worked for the IRS as an agent in Bridgeton and Camden. Then, while working for Gayner Glass in Salem as the comptroller he began his own business, J.P. Warner Public Accountant out of his home in Alloway. After several years and having established his business, he moved his office to Woodstown.
