John H. "Robbie" Robinson, age 86, of Woodstown passed away on March 28, 2022. Born to the late Harry and Myrtis (Kiesel) Robinson, he was a lifelong Salem County resident, growing up in Penns Grove and graduating from Penns Grove High School.
