Joseph E. Wentzell “Joe”, age 81, of Pittsgrove Township, NJ passed away on October 24, 2023 following a year long battle with cancer.

Born in Camden, NJ to the late William E. Wentzell and Mary (Sagers) Wentzell, Joe attended Bridgeton High School and received his GED after having left to join the workforce. He ran a computer room for Owens Corning Fiberglass. During his off hours, he operated Wentzell’s Nursery, a wholesale and retail tree farm he inherited from his father. Joe also worked for Erdner Brothers in Woodstown, NJ as a truck driver for 25 years. After retirement he took great pride in serving on the Pittsgrove Township School Board.

Joe’s love of books is eclipsed only by his love of the outdoors. He enjoyed shooting sports, archery, hunting, and fishing. He was highly regarded for his marksmanship and reloading capabilities. He was a lifetime member of USANA in Elmer, NJ and Quinton Sportsman Club in Quinton, NJ. He competed in sporting clay competitions well into his 70s. He was content at the gun club, surrounded by like-minded friends.

Above all else, Joe was a family man. He took great lengths to support his kids, grandkids, and great grandkids at their sporting events, recitals, performances, or just being there for emotional support. His smile conveyed joy and acceptance for his entire brood. The love of his life was Angela

(Taylor) Wentzell who predeceased him by 19 years. The two of them enjoyed over 40 years of marriage, often traveling to fun destinations with extended family and friends.
