Kenneth D. Camp of Pittsgrove, NJ passed on to be with the Lord on Sunday, September 10, 2006 at the New Jersey Memorial Home, Vineland, NJ. Born and raised in Monroeville, NJ, he was 80 years old. Mr. Camp was a WWII Navy veteran with eight years of service. He "Proudly" served with the U. S. Navy's Armed Guards, which were sailors assigned to Merchant Marine (Liberty Ships) during the war.
