Kyle E. Flynn, age 46, passed away peacefully on Saturday, March 25th, 2023, at the Mullica Hill Inspira Medical Center after losing his battle with cancer.

Kyle was born on May 28th, 1976 to W. Daniel & Judith (Mobus) Flynn of Pittsgrove, NJ. After twelve mind-numbing years in public school, he decided to challenge himself and joined the US Navy in 1995 and was assigned aboard the USS John C. Stennis (CVN 74) aircraft carrier. After the Navy, he traveled and lived in various places before finally settling in Elmer, NJ where he has been a long-time resident.

Kyle worked for Rapid Response Inc., in the furniture repair division, as the National Service Manager for nearly 15 years and managed a team of repair technicians along the East Coast. Prior to that he worked as a manager for another furniture repair company for more than 8 years. He was a hard worker, enjoyed his job and was dedicated to the success of the company he worked for.

He spent most of his spare time helping others, whether neighbors, friends or family as he was the "go to fix-it guy" for any project or repair and could do just about anything with ease. He also enjoyed cars, mostly sports cars, traveling adventures with friends and annual vacations, running 5K races with

his Dad and hosting countless parties and good times with friends and family. Always had good music, good food and good times with lots of fun. He worked hard and played hard living life to the fullest.

Kyle was the life of the party with his quick wit, sarcasm, hilarious sense of humor and animated story telling. He would capture a whole room and make everyone roar with laughter. His finest jokes were the sarcastic ones. He will truly be a tough act to follow. Even in everyday conversations he could not help but infuse humor into a sentence or two to make someone laugh. Some would call it a gift.

Kyle was devoted to his family, friends and community of neighbors who became his friends. He looked out for them, and they looked out for him when he became ill. He always made time whenever someone needed him. He was the most caring, loyal and bluntly honest person; proudly letting you know he was "going to tell you like it is" but he would let you know respectfully, he was also very genuine. He never complained about much and would rather make a sarcastic joke about something or find the humor in even the worst times. He always made others feel good and reminded us that it's never really "that bad", even if it was.
