Laura Gardiner, 90, of Woodstown passed away on September 12, 2023. Born in Woodbury and raised in Pilesgrove Township, NJ. Mrs. Gardiner was the daughter of Lawrence & Anna Moore Broomell. She graduated from Woodstown High School in 1951 and went on to attend Douglas College in NJ for Woman. After meeting her husband J. Willard Gardiner in high school they got married in 1954. A well-liked natural leader with a wry sense of humour, she was a member of the Woodstown Friends Meeting, worked for the Salem County 4H Extension Service, and served as a 4H Leader. After retiring, Laura and Willard moved to Brant Lake, NY and enjoyed living the Adirondack life for twenty-seven years before moving back to Friends Village. During that time, the two of them did a ninety mile Adirondack Canoe Classic and started downhill skiing at age 57, eventually traveling to New Zealand and the Italian Alps to ski. Some of her other hobbies included, but were not limited to sewing, quilting and knitting.

She is survived by her husband, with whom she just celebrated their sixty-ninth wedding anniversary, J. Willard Gardiner; three children, Joy Gardiner and her husband Harold Kalmus, Elizabeth Gardiner and her husband Mark Brozina and Dennis Gardiner and his wife Laurie as well as four grandchildren, Kayla, Lindsey, Grace and Rachel. In addition to her parents, a sister Doris Broomell Gardiner predeceased her.
