Leon "Lee" Tice, 74, of Upper Deerfield passed away on October 11, 2010. Born in Seeley (Upper Deerfield), he was the son of Leon V. & Edna Tice. Mr. Tice was a member of the Elmer United Methodist Church and was self employed as a Dairy Farmer. He was member of the Upper Deerfield Fire Company #1, served on the Executive Committee for the Cumberland County Board of Agriculture, former member of the 4-H Advisory Committee and former Director for the Cumberland County Fair. Lee was a graduated of the Bridgeton High School Class of 1955.
