Linwood H. Dilks, 89, of Harmersville passed away on Saturday, May 26, 2007 at the Southgate HealthCare Center in Carney's Point. Born in Harmersville, he was the son of Loren and Ethel (Smick) Dilks. Over the years, he worked for the Sunoco Station on Griffith St., in Salem (1936-1941 & 1945-1953), Davis Dodge (1953-1977) and then as the Superintendent of the Lower Alloways Creek Public Works (1977-1987). He was a member of the Canton Baptist Church, where he served as a Deacon for over sixty years and taught Sunday School for many years. Mr. Dilks served on the LAC School Board for six years, the Board of Directors at the Memorial Hospital of Salem County for fifty years (1952-2002) and the Board of Directors for the Franklin Savings Bank (1962-2007). In addition, he served in the U.S. Army during the Second World War, 3rd Infantry Division 5th Army. He is survived by his daughters, Marilyn A. Dilks of Harmersville, Nancy L. Brobst of N.H., and Betty J. Boulden of LAC, a brother, J. Alvin Dilks of Florida, seven grandchildren, Kenneth, David, Jenny and Mark Brobst and Tara, Erin and Seth Boulden and four great grandchildren, Caleb, Kelly, Sydney and Loryn Brobst. His wife Marjorie and a sister Marion predeceased him. Services will be held on Saturday, June 2, 2007 at the Canton Baptist Church, 700 Smick Rd., Canton, NJ at 11am.
