Louise Ollweiler, age 89, died on May 9, 2022 in Woodstown, New Jersey. Born in Freeport, Illinois, she was the daughter of Mary and Clayton Gehman. She grew up in Pennsylvania and graduated from Windber High School and Juniata College.

She taught English in Cumberland Valley High School, Mechanicsburg, PA. She was married to the late Frank Ollweiler 38 years, and they lived most of that time in New Jersey. She was a proofreader for the Trenton Times, later a part-time reporter for Today's Sunbeam. In subsequent years, she was a proofreader and an assistant editor for Auerbach Publishers, and she was an associate editor/analyst for Datapro Research Corporation, publishing reports about computers.

She taught English and American History part-time in the mid-1980s in the Continuing Education Program in the Salem County Vo-Tech School. The Institute for Research in Chicago published the career booklets that she wrote for students on the subjects of antiques, telecommunications, bookkeeping and furniture stores.

Surviving are her two sisters, Elaine Rhodes of Timonium, MD and Hazel Berkey of Windber, PA. She was predeceased by a third sister, Helen Hegedus of Windber, PA. She is also survived by six nephews and two nieces

and their families.
