In January of this year, Margy had been appointed as the Deputy Tax Collector for Carney’s Point Township. In 2013, Margy decided to take several courses offered by Rutgers University Center for Government Services in Tax Collection I, II and III. All of which she had successfully completed that year and as a result she was scheduled to sit for the State Tax Collector Exam this fall. In addition to this, Margy had served as the Tax Clerk and Tax Assessor Clerk, which she was appointed to in June of 2012, the Secretary to the Planning Board from 2011 until 2014 and Assistant Zoning Officer from 2011 in Carney’s Point as well. Prior to this, she had worked for West Jersey Title Agency for sixteen years.
