Mariann Frances Savarese, 95, of Carneys Point passed away on February 15, 2017. A devout catholic, Mariann was a member of the Parish of St. Gabriel the Archangel, the Senior Saints, the Mother of Grace Society and the Altar and Rosary Society. She was also a member of the Washington

Club. Mariann was a kind and loving lady who was very strong in her faith. You would never find her without her rosary beads in her hands. She was always praying for her family and anyone else who would call her with a special prayer request. Heaven has certainly gained a special angel.
