Marie Avis, 92, born in Washington Township and formerly of Monroeville, passed away on November 8, 2013. Born Erva Marie Epley to the late Fred and Erva Epley, Marie was a 1939 graduate of Glassboro High School and in 1940 she married Stanley Avis with whom she would spend the next 69 years until he passed in 2009. With her husband, Marie co-operated Avis Volkswagen beginning in their garage in Monroeville in 1952 and later relocated the dealership to Route 40 in 1958 until they would retire in 1976. During their time running the dealership, Stanley and Marie enjoyed several trips to Germany for Volkswagen dealer meetings and tours of the factory and, after retirement, the two would spend their time traveling across the country in their motor home. Marie was a wonderful cook and most recently she resided at the Terraces at Parke Place in Sewell where she was very active in taking care of the store there as well as helping out with the running of the residents' meeting.
