Marie Danks (Re), 67, of Carneys Point, NJ, passed away on July 4, 2025. She was a woman of deep roots, strong opinions, and a heart that showed up in ways only those closest to her truly understood.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, she was the daughter of John J. Danks, Jr. and the late Marie (Fitzmire) Danks. She moved to Penns Grove during her high school years and graduated from Penns Grove High School in 1976. Over the years, she worked as a clerk for both the Borough of Penns Grove and the Penns Grove Sewerage Authority, where she became a familiar face to many in the community.
