Mark Edward Brown, age 60, of Glassboro went home to be with his Lord and savior, Jesus November 19th, 2020. Born in Elmer, NJ to Russell & Evelyn (Beckett) Brown on April 22nd, 1960, he grew up in Aldine and later moved to Penns Grove. While attending high school, he met the love of his life Wendy Bowers (Brown). They spent 41 years together, 38 married and had four beautiful children and five grandchildren that brought him so much joy. They started their life together in Auburn and Pedricktown and later settled in Glassboro where his wife and daughter currently reside with his dog which was his very best friend Bear Bear.

Back in 1978, shortly after Mark and Wendy met, he took an entry level position as a warehouse loader at Anchor Hocking in Salem. Not too long after that he had a tragic automobile accident which put his life in jeopardy. The complications were severe with a 6 month recovery which included a 2 week coma. He was up against the fight of his life. He was told he would never walk again, never have children and never be able to work again. His love and dedication to Wendy along with his determination and God's help, he was able to regain most function which enabled him to once again walk, have his 4 children and went on to to work his way up to a position in the company as a machine operator. Even though his job wasn't the most glamorous, it was his passion and what he did best. He truly loved his job and is remembered fondly for telling those stories. Anchor gave him the opportunity

for growth to provide for his family and give them the life he always wanted. Near the end of his career he was diagnosed with MS & Parkinson's which led him to an early retirement after 33 years. Mark and his wife enjoyed traveling and spending time with their friends known as their "Elvis family".

Mark is survived by his wife Wendy, and children Christopher, Kevin and Stephanie. Along with his grandchildren Joshua, Danica, Ki'laya, Noah and Israel. Also his brother Raymond, sister Beth and her children and his brother Dale and his children. He is also predeceased by his daughter Jennifer, his father Russell, brother Dennis and mother Evelyn.

The family will have a memorial service for friends and family at a later date to be announced.

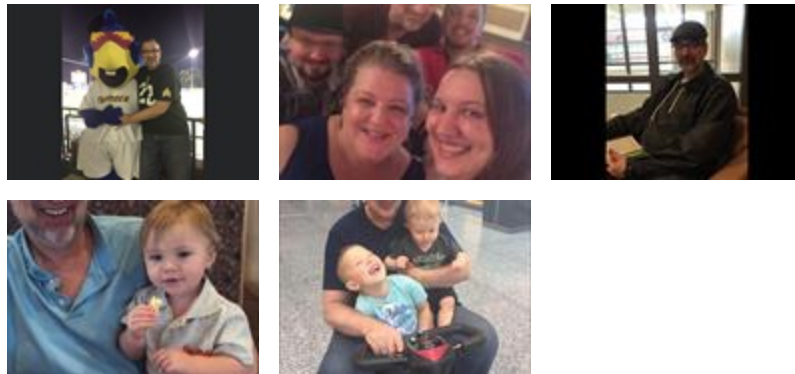
