Mark D. Cagle, Sr., 59 of Logan Township, passed away peacefully on January 30, 2021, with his wife and children at his side, at Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital following a massive heart attack.

Mark moved to Pedricktown at the age of 10 and was a 1980 graduate of Penns Grove High School.
