Mary Jane Ecret, 88, of Pennsville, N.J., passed away into eternal life on November 13, 2023, in the company of Tina, Jeff, and Mike, her loving children. Born in Penns Grove N.J. in 1935 to parents Antonio Sr. and Nicoletta (Perlozzo) Luzzo, Mary graduated from Penns Grove High School in 1954 and married the love of her life, James Ecret, in 1957. Ten years later, she and her adoring husband opened their family business, Ecret's Flower Shop, in Pennsville. The shop thrived in the town that Mary loved for over fifty years – a testament to her enduring strength and work ethic amidst the struggles of motherhood and the passing of her husband. Residents of Pennsville will remember Mary always as a pillar of their community, both for her compassion and for the beauty her store brought to the area.

In addition to being a loving mother and a dedicated business owner, Mary was also a devout Catholic. She was a devoted member of Queen of Apostles Roman Catholic (RC) Church in Pennsville, N.J. until its closing on September 4, 2016. She then became an active parishioner at Our Lady of Fatima RC Church in New Castle, DE. Mary committed herself to living as God intended, and our admiration of her is proof that she succeeded. In every way, she embodied the grace, compassion, and selflessness that all Catholics strive toward.

Mary's memory lives on in her three children, Tina Pendrak (Joe) of Pennsville, NJ, Jeffrey Ecret (Lisa) of Wilmington, DE, and Michael Ecret (DiAnn) of Pennsville, NJ; her eight grandchildren, Joseph, Brandon (Kaylee), Elayna, Elijah, Mary Anne (Jeff), Joseph (Christine), John (Eilee), and Jacob; her three great grandchildren, Chase, Clair, and Nico; and her beloved sister Jean Tigue.
