



McHughe Mac Griffin

McHughe (Mac) Griffin of Pedricktown passed away on June 30, 2012 at the age of 89. Prior to moving to his nieces home in Pedricktown, Maxine Catts, Mac had lived in Pennsville. He was born on July 1, 1922 in Polkton, NC., a small town in Anson County. He was the son of Hiram D. & Gracey Caudle Griffin. Mac was one of eleven children, seven boys and one girl. All seven boys served in the military, Army, Navy, Marines and Air Force, for a total of 126 1/2 years, five of the boys served in World War II. Mac was the last surviving child.

He moved to New Jersey in 1939 and worked for Pure Carbonic Co., a Division of Air Reduction Sales Company. He also worked for DuPont's at Plant One and Chambers Works, East Area and Blue Products. He retired in 1984 from B.O.C. Gases with 40 1/2 years of service. When he was not working, he loved to spend time fishing in the Delaware Bay.

Mac is survived by his sister-in-laws, Dorothy Sparks of Pedricktown and Edna Prigger of Carney's Point; a brother-in-law, Dr. William Prigger of California as well as several nieces and nephews in New Jersey and North Carolina. His first wife Ruth Sparks Griffin, a daughter, Janet Lee Griffin Brandt and wife Mildred Prigger Griffin predeceased him.

Services will be held on Friday, July 6, 2012 at the First Baptist Church of

Pedricktown, 89 West Mill St., Pedicktown. The viewing will begin at 10 AM with the service following at 11 AM. Interment will take place at the Hudson Methodist Church Cemetery.
