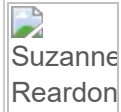

(with my broken arm and a move to a new place on Nov 30th, I am still looking for my address book so we can talk sometime. He would tell me about your children and your work . He would also always ask about my girls . Can you text me and give me your phone number and address?

I was to meet Mike at Julia's house in Catonsville (one of his old hang outs) We were to meet at 11 or 12 on October 29 and then I was going to treat him to crabs for his birthday! His phone was all backed up with uncleared messages so, I really didn't worry too much at first! He would show up when he got there. Only he didn't. Then, I subconsciously started to worry. That is when the next day I broke my right arm in 4 places and flew back to Maryland on Nov. 1st in horrific pain. Kathy called me after the funeral and told me he died on November 3rd. After she told me of his diagnosis and what happened afterwards, I don't think it really sunk into me. I am still dealing with the aftermath of his death and moved a into a one bedroom apartment near Kristen, my oldest daughter who at 44 had her 1st baby- a girl . Julia has 2 girls , ages 5 and 2. I moved into a one bedroom apt to be near Mayo Clinic (which is the reason I moved here.)My number is 401 439 2980 . I like texting the best. It is easier for me. (Mike and I both hated technology and had no patience with it!) I have a new iPhone and know the basics.Kicking and screaming several years ago, I put his application into the VA for him. We got it done and he liked the perks (the best medical coverage,AARP for him and his family and taking a loan to buy his sweet little cottage he loved so much! I put a fire stove just like his in my house in RI which he saw when he visited one time. That was it! He built his own as you know and did all the brick work. He was so smart and skilled! What an amazing mind! Hope you are all doing well- I know how hard it is to lose you Dad. I lost mine at 70 from double lung cancer. I also called him Pop. I think that is what drew me to Mike, they were so much alike. So, in a way, I found him again through Michael.

Oh, ps, all the pictures were wonderful displayed on his Memory wall. And the Obituary you wrote was amazing! That was him for sure! I saw two pictures I would like to have if you could copy them for me some time- no hurry, believe me, I know how busy working Mom's are! But, the two I like best where the one of the two of you- you were in your cap and gown and he had his arm around you and had on a blue shirt. You both looked so happy and him so proud having loved you and helped you along the way. The other one is the one with him and your kids sitting on the ground. He couldn't have been more proud! 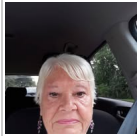
