A devoted husband, father, grandfather and brother, Othello "Garb" Garbini, 89, of Penns Grove passed away on April 7, 2010 at his home. Born in West Virginia, Mr. Garbini was the son of Alessandro & Maria Garbini. He was a member of St. James R.C. Church and served in the U.S. Army during WWII, retiring from the Army Reserves as a Colonel. For many years, he worked in and owned the family bar in Penns Grove, "Garbini's". Later, he served the community as Director of Public Safety for Penns Grove; the Warden at the Salem County Correctional Facility; and also served on the Penns Grove Planning Board. In time, he also assisted his wife, Betty, in her business, "Korner Antiques".
