Paul Haynes Sr., 80, of Pennsville, NJ, went home to be with the Lord on November 16. Paul was deeply loved by all who knew him, and was affectionately known to all the children around him as “Pop Pop” or “Grandpop”, and to most others as “Pop” or “Radar”.

Paul was born in Haywood County, NC on April 27, 1926, and moved to New Jersey at the age of 14. He served in the Army and was stationed in the Philippines during WWII. He retired from DuPont Chambers Works in 1982 after 38 years of service, continuing his tree service throughout the 90s, and his salvage and reclaim business right up until the time of his death.

Paul was pre-deceased by his first wife, Dorothy Collier Haynes of Deepwater, NJ, in 1980, his sister, Rubie Haynes Haney in 1950, and his daughter-in-law, Maryellen Jerram Haynes in 1987. He is survived by his second wife, Martha Faye Stone Haynes, of Pennsville (originally from Tifton, GA), and 5 children: Marie Williams, wife of Charlie Williams, of Pennsville, NJ, Paul G Haynes, Jr. of Chicago, IL, Marcia Percy, wife of Richard Percy, of Sebring, FL, Dale Haynes, husband of Tracey Haynes, of Pennsville, NJ, and Danny Hall-Haynes of Pennsville, NJ.

Paul leaves behind 10 grandchildren: Lori, Megan and Ryan Williams, Jerry Rynkowski, Toni Torre, Ricky and Lorie Percy, Sommer Hofacker, Jesse and Taylor Haynes, and 3 great-grandchildren: Raeanne Mills, Dante Torre and Dalton Percy.

There will be two viewing services held at Pennsville Church of the Nazarene at 172 Churchtown Road in Pennsville, NJ: the first between 6:30-9:00 PM on Monday, November 20. The second will be held on Tuesday, November 21 at 10:00 AM. The funeral service will be held at the church immediately after, beginning at 11:00 AM. Reverend Bruce Ratliff will be officiating.
