Paul H. Irelan, 90, of Pitman passed away on September 5, 2015. Born in Stow Creek, Mr. Irelan was the son of the late Benjamin & Pauline (Harris) Irelan. He is survived by his sons, Paul Irelan, Jr., John Irelan and his wife Eva-Marie, grandchildren, Tyler, Dori and Toby, siblings, Larry Irelan (Janet) and Catherine I. Homan, many more family members and friends as well as two individuals who held a special place in his heart, Greg and Tom. In addition to his parents, his wife of thirty-six years, Doris (Moore) and four brothers, Richard, Frank, Benjamin and George predeceased him.

Sweet, kind and gentle were the words used to describe Paul H. Irelan. When you asked Paul what were the most important things in his life he would simply tell you, his relationship with God, spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren as well as the time he spent on the family farm. He prayed for everyone and as a result everyone would refer to him as a "Prayer Warrior". His favorite book was the Bible and over the years he worn out many a copy. He worked for and would eventually retire from the Soil Conservation Service, which was a part of the Department of Agriculture, but also during that time he worked for WKDN Radio, which was a Christian radio station. Paul was a member of the Christian Missionary Alliance Church in Sewell, where he often helped out with the Awana Program for kids. Years back he had been a Sunday School Teacher with Chapel Heights Methodist Church. A veteran of our armed forces, Mr. Irelan served in the U.S. Navy

during WWII.


