Pete Dane Fisher, 74, of Pittsgrove, NJ and a life-long resident of Salem County, passed away on Tuesday, March 28, 2023. Born at the Salem County Memorial Hospital, Pete was the son of the late Elmer Everett Fisher and Gertrude (Cook) Fisher and was a 1967 graduate of Bridgeton High School. In 1969, Pete was wed to Donna Zinni and was drafted into the United States Army where he served as a mechanic in Germany during the Vietnam War.

Upon his return, Pete worked for a couple of years at DuPont Chambers Works and worked for Hines Hofer Builders in Gloucester County until 1985 when he started his own business, T & D Construction, where he specialized in roofing, siding and construction.
