Peter Trofim Daticuk, age 73, of Pittsgrove Township, NJ passed away on Sunday, February 5, 2023. Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Peter and Alice (Miller) Daticuk. When Peter was 5 years old, his family moved to Sewell and he was a 1967 graduate of Clearview High School. After high school, Peter proudly served his country as a Cobra Helicopter pilot in Vietnam in the United States Army and Army Reserve from 1968 to 1975, where he was shot down twice.

In 1969, Peter married Beverly Ann Strawn, and they began their family as Peter worked as a self-employed construction contractor. In 2000, they moved to Pittsgrove. Peter was an avid deer hunter and he liked to go fishing. He will be remembered as a simple hard-working man who loved his family.

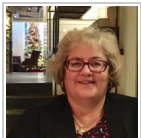
