Ralph J. Tighe, age 85, a lifelong resident of Oldmans Township, NJ passed away on September 1, 2024. Born in Camden to the late James and Mary Cecelia (Lane) Tighe, Ralph was a 1958 graduate of Woodstown High School and went on to further his education at Colorado State University. Over the years, he owned and operated his vegetable farm, Tighe Farms. He was a devout Catholic and a parishioner of the Catholic Community of the Holy Spirit.

To say that Ralph loved football would be an understatement; he played at Woodstown, Colorado State and for the semi-pro Swedesboro Devils. He was one of the founding members of the Woodstown Pirates organization and coached the Woodstown Buccaneers. Ralph attended every Woodstown football game that he was able to get to. 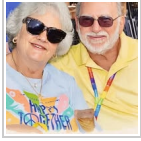
