Ray Edward Zarin, Sr., 80, passed away peacefully on August 12, 2018 at his home in Egg Harbor Township, NJ with his family by his side. Ray was born on the family farm on June 2, 1938 in Penton, NJ to John and Mary Zarin. Ray served in the United States Coast Guard for 4 years. After returning from duty, he worked for DuPont Chambers Works where he was employed as a crane operator until his retirement in 1993. Ray went on to own and manage Tomorrow's World, a preschool, in Marmora. His next venture was as a co-owner of Amanda's, a lady's boutique, in Millville up until 2013. Ray was known for his love of baseball. He managed his beloved Penton Cubs from 1970-1992. The team played every Sunday evening in Penton and won 9 championships, the most memorable time was when they won 3 years in a row. Ray was inducted into the Salem County Hall of Fame in 2014.

Ray is predeceased by his first wife, Joann Seeney Zarin and also his second wife, Cheryl Snyder Zarin. His parents, John and Mary Zarin and brother, John Zarin, Jr. all met him at Heaven's gates as well. His memory and legacy will be kept alive by his and Joann's children, Robin Stenson Zarin and Ray (Andrea) Zarin, and their grandchildren Andrea (Robert) Murphy, Alex Stenson, and Nicolette and Victoria Zarin. In addition, Ray is now survived by his step-daughter Brooke (Dennis) Taylor, and their three children Aaron, Allee and Mason Taylor. He also leaves behind his siblings, Wilburt Zarin, Carol Cocco, and Maryann Grant, several nieces and nephews, and many other loved ones

and friends. Ray also now predeceases his fiancée, Carol Grusemeyer.
