It should also be mentioned that while he was in college Mr. Sheriffs worked for the East Long Meadow Police Department in Massachusetts. Having been civic minded throughout his life, he was extremely proud of the fact that he had served his country in both the United States Marine Corp. and the U.S. Air Force from 1950 through 1956. For many years he worked for the YMCA. After that he was employed at Salem Community College in the Admissions and Testing office. From there he went to Salem County Board of Social Services where he retired from in 2008. Wanting to keep himself busy, Ron started working at the courthouse in Carney's Point after retiring.

Ron has been a member of Calvary Baptist Church in Carney's Point for many years. During that time, he has served the church in many different roles and capacities including being the church treasurer, a position he just recently stepped down from. He served on The Board of Directors for the American RSD Hope.
