Samuel Michael Donovan, 73, of Alloway, New Jersey, died at home on Tuesday, April 22, 2025, surrounded by the people and pets who meant the most to him.

Born in Woodbury and raised in Washington Township, Sam was truly one of a kind — fiercely principled, sharp with his wit, and never without that twinkle in his eye. He worked harder than just about anyone you've ever met, and the word quit simply wasn't in his vocabulary.

Sam served in the United States Air Force, though he rarely spoke of it — feeling undeserving of recognition because he was never deployed, while close friends were lost to Vietnam. But his service was real, and his sense of loyalty and sacrifice ran deep.

Sam had paint on his hands, clothes, and in his hair for most of the last 45 years. He learned from old-school sign painters — men who hand-lettered truck doors and billboards before computers took over the trade. He moved on from towering liquor ads and Marlboro Men to large-scale, hand-painted murals both indoors and out, creating work across the region that left a lasting impression.

In his later years, he turned his attention to what he loved most: the rural

landscapes and farm country he grew up with. Still with paint on his hands and in his thinning hair, he painted for himself — but always hoped others would enjoy it, too.

Sam met his wife Carol in Wildwood, and together they built a life he loved in Alloway — one filled with coffee, time in the woods, and the kind of everyday moments that mattered most. If he wasn't painting, he was bowhunting or fishing — and if he wasn't bowhunting or fishing, he was wishing he was. He is survived by Carol; daughters Becky (Christopher) and Sarah (Brett); grandchildren Liam, Grayson, and Ayla; sisters Debby and Marianne; and his beloved dogs, Jake and Joe.

He was predeceased by his father Granville, his mother Doris, grandmothers Helen and Priscilla, and his uncle Jordan.

A service and celebration of Sam's life will be held on Saturday, June 28, 2025 at 11:00 a.m. at the Millville Army Air Field Museum, with lunch to follow.

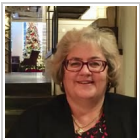
