Sherman Joseph McMonigal, age 79, of Pedricktown passed away on February 22, 2019. Born and raised in Three Springs, PA, he was the son of the late John and Margaret (Holden) McMonigal. Sherman was a 1958 graduate of Orbisonia High School and, shortly after, joined the United States Army and was stationed at the Nike Missile Base in Swedesboro. Sherman worked at the DuPont Experimental Station as a boiler and air conditioning technician in the "Powerhouse" and he retired from there in 1992.
