When he wasn't attending all the various activities, Stanley and June spent many vacations camping and hiking up and down the east coast.

He is survived by his first wife Marie Newkirk (Bob), their sons, Keith and Scott Redrow, and his grand daughter Macayla Frampton (Ivan); longtime companion June Carlantonio, her daughter Michelle Redrow (Mark), and her grandchildren Charlee and Jaycee Redrow. He is also survived by his
