



## Stephen Dupree Miller

Stephen Dupree Miller, 79, of Piles Grove, passed away quietly on September 27, 2015. Mr. Miller retired in 1999 as President and CEO of First Home Savings, where he worked for 30 years. Mr. Miller was born in Woodbury to the late Garland & Florence (Shoemaker) Miller. He is survived by his wife, Hannelore (nee: Uhlig); by his children, Dirk Miller (Adrienne) and Stephenie Beauchamp (Bruce); by his grandchildren, Lauren Reinhard, Graham Reinhard and Brianna G. Miller; and by his brother Garland D. Miller (Rhoda Ann) from Wenonah.

A graduate of Swedesboro High School, he attended Temple University where he received an Associates degree in Architecture. While attending school, he worked as a teller at the Swedesboro Trust Co. Not long thereafter, he joined First Home Savings and Loan, and working his way up the ranks eventually became President & CEO. During his career, Stephen was a member of the Penns Grove Rotary and became a Paul Harris Fellow. He was a long time member of the Trinity Episcopal Church in Swedesboro where he served on the church's board. Mr. Miller recently retired as a board member from the Health and Wellness Group that was established after the sale of Salem Memorial Hospital. He was a proud service member in U.S. Army, serving as a Morse code translator. In addition to his family, the one thing that brought Stephen a tremendous amount of joy was his 1955 Chevy Bel Air.

A Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, October 3, 2015 at the Trinity Episcopal Church, 1208 Kings Hwy., Swedesboro, NJ 08085.
