Stephenson H. Wright, 91, of Elmer died on February 6, 2006 at his home. Born in Wildwood, he was the son of the late Wilbur and Gertrude Wright. Prior to moving to Elmer 30 years ago, he had lived in Pennsville for many years. Mr. Wright was a graduate of Drexel University with a degree in Electrical Engineering and went on to work for Duponts for the next forty years retiring in 1978 as an Electrical Supervisor in Engineering. In addition to the love he had for his family, Stephenson devoted his life to the Fraternal Order of Free and Accepted Masons. He was a member and Past Master of the Penns Grove Lodge #54 and the tyler at the Elmer Lodge #160 of Free and Accepted Masons. In addition, he was a member of the Scottish Rite, The Royal Arch Masons, Royal Select Masters, Knights Templar, York Rite College #18, Red Cross of Constantine and the Knights of the York Cross of Honour. A trumpet player as well, he played for the American Legion Band, the Shriners Club, the Pennsville Community Band, the YMCA Orchestra and the Tall Cedars. He is survived by his wife Ruth (nee: VanCulin) whom he married in 1951, his daughters, Jane Ford and her husband Stanley of Virginia, and Evelyn "Billie" Scott of Elmer, his son P. Wayne Wright and his wife Grace of Florida, seven grandchildren and nine great grandchildren. His son John "Jack" Wright, a sister Neretta Folz and a grandson James "Bud" Scott predeceased him. The Viewing and Service will be held at the Penns Grove Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons, 330 Georgetown Rd., Carney's Point. The viewing will take place Thursday night, February 9, 2006 starting at
