Steven J. DuBois, 72, of Pittsgrove passed away on June 10, 2024. Steve was the son of Henry & Lois Weber DuBois and was raised on the family farm. He was a 1970 graduate of Bridgeton High School, where he was an active FFA member. Steve competed at the National FFA Convention and was the Tractor Driving Champion in 1969. He attended SUNY Cobleskill College of Agriculture and Technology in upstate New York. Steve with his brother Henry were 6th generation farmers. Together they operated the very progressive H & S DuBois Farms where they took pride in growing quality vegetables for the frozen food industry and grain. Of all the crops grown over the years, Spinach was Steve's favorite crop to grow and often referred to it as "Spinach The Crisis Crop" which was the title of a presentation he once gave at the New York State Vegetable Growers Association Annual Convention. Farming was Steve's passion and nothing made him prouder then watching his two sons grow up on the farm working side by side with him, and both having careers in agriculture themselves. In the winter months, Steve enjoyed several skiing and snowmobile trips with his boys most memorably riding near the Grand Teton Mountains in Wyoming. Steve was a people person and enjoyed visiting with all of the local farmers as well as taking photographs of agriculture. He had a strong interest in local agricultural history, especially of Seabrook Farms, as he was a walking history book of knowledge. Steve absolutely loved his beagle dog, Lucky Girl, which they spent countless hours together. Spending time with his grandchildren always brought the biggest smile to his

face.

He is survived by his wife of nearly 47 years Linda (nee: DeCoste); his sons, Steven DuBois, Jr. and his wife Janelle and Michael DuBois and his wife Mary; siblings, Henry DuBois Jr. and his wife Marlene, Ruth Ann Fox and her husband Paul, and Christian DuBois as well as seven grandchildren, Ethan, Karson, Konnor, Landon, Lauren, Travis and Trent.

Services will be held on Saturday, June 15, 2024 at the Adams Funeral Home, 64 Broad St., Woodstown, NJ 08098. The viewing will begin at 10 AM with the service following at 12 PM.
