Sue Jean McCracken Foster, 89, of Pilesgrove peacefully passed away on November 7, 2021 with family by her side. Born in Daretown, Jean was the daughter of Dwight M. & Kathleen (Allen) McCracken. She graduated from Woodstown High School in 1950. Her first job was with F.W. Woolworth's 5 & 10 in Bridgeton, she was the secretary to the Supervisor of Quality Control at Kimble Glass, an Avon Lady for five years, a seamstress at the M.B. Dress Company in Gibbstown, a scale operator for one summer at H.J. Heinz Company and retired from John P. Warner's Accounting Firm in Woodstown.

She was a former leader of the Salem County 4-H Group "Stitch n' Stew" and was an assistant to the leader of the South Harrison Township 4-H Crafters. Teaching crochet, needlepoint, tole painting and making hand stamped gift and greeting cards. Jean served as the Editor of the newsletter, "The 907th Tow Rope" and was the Secretary and Treasurer of the 907th Glider Field Artillery Battalion, Division of the 101st Airborne Association. In 1990, as members of the 907th 101st Airborne Group, she and her husband, Albert "Junie" Foster, accepted an invitation by the Queen and members of the former Dutch Resistance Group to a ten-day reunion in the Netherlands. During the trip they were able to visit former battle sites of the 907th group at Bastogne, where the Battle of the Bulge took place and Hitler's "Eagles Nest".

This is where, Albert's 101st group, was on the day the war ended in Europe on May 7, 1945 (officially May 8, 1945).

She was also a member of the South Harrison Township Senior Citizen's Group, acting as the substitute secretary and the Salem County Genealogical Society holding the position of Recording Secretary.

She is survived by her two daughters, Beverly Sue "Suzie" Richards (Robert) and Dana Lou Bussey (Steven); four grandchildren, Matthew Richards (Jennifer), Elena Wentz (Bradley), Jeanna DuBois (Joshua) and Derek Bussey (Jorge Vasquez), as well as six great grandchildren, Alexis and Connor Richards, Mason and Emma DuBois, Dean and Allison Wentz. In addition to her parents and husband, Albert "Junie" Foster, she was predeceased by siblings, Jack McCracken, Betty Hiles, Nancy Thomas and Paulette Hickman.
