Virginia "Ginny" Louise Loufik, age 72, of Carneys Point passed away on Tuesday, July 10, 2018. Born in Camden, she was the daughter of the late Harry T. and Virginia (Fawcett) Monroe. Raised in Paulsboro, Ginny was a 1964 graduate of Paulsboro High School. After high school, Ginny and her husband Joseph Racite, Jr. moved around to different towns and ultimately settled down in the Carneys Point area in the late 1960's. In her early years, she was a homemaker, raising her five children and after the children were grown, she worked in the warehouse at Genco in Swedesboro for 13 years. She enjoyed crocheting and going out with her sisters, usually shopping and eating out at the Olive Garden. Ginny will be remembered as a loving wife, mother, sister and aunt and she will be dearly missed by her family.

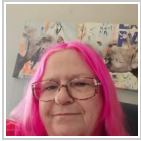
