Virginia Saull, 78, of Pilesgrove passed away on July 31, 2016. Born in Dallas, TX, Virginia was the daughter of Albert T. & Esther Louise Ellis. The family would eventually move to Salem County and she would graduate from Penns Grove High School in 1956. She married her husband Donald in 1959, whom she was happily married to for fifty-four years, and the two of them raised four children, Laura, Susan, Jennifer and Donald. Not only was she a wife, mother and grandmother, she also worked as a home health aide, a bookkeeper for ten years and a trade analyst for the DuPont Co. Over the years she also volunteered for many organizations, however, after a family member was diagnosed with mental illness, Virginia wanted to learn all she could about it. So, along with her husband they came to NAMI. She would become a strong advocate for the mentally ill and would eventually become the President of the Salem County Chapter of NAMI. Over the years she was recognized with many awards, The Inter Agency Council Community Education Award in 2003 and in the 2014 The Lifetime Affiliate Leadership Award to name a few, for her hard work in bettering the lives of those with a mental illness. She was also known for her outstanding penmanship, stenciling, her home made candles and her legendary fried chicken. Virginia was also a member of St. Joseph's RC Church and had served on the Altar and Rosary Society.

In addition to her children, Laura Smith and her husband Matt, Susan Bealmear, Jennifer Price and her husband Rob, his son Donald Saull II, and her sister Linda Ann Benedetti. She is also survived by her grandchildren, Rachael and Andrew Taft, Joshua Bealmear and Katie Smith. Her adopted grandchildren include, Anna, Jamey, Zach, Nick, Noah, Ricky and Emily. Her adopted daughters, Wendy Tighe and Brittany France, as well as many nieces and nephews also survive her. In addition to her parents, her husband Donald predeceased her in 2013.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be said on Friday, August 5, 2016 at St. Joseph's RC Church, 51 Broad St., Woodstown, NJ.
