Walter E. Voeckler, Jr., age 76, of Elmer went home to be with his Lord on Thursday, November 30, 2017. Walt was born at the home of his grandparents on Laurel Lane in Pittsgrove to the late Walter E. Voeckler, Sr. and Nellie C. Wescott Voeckler and he resided in Elmer most of his life.

Walt was a Certified Lay Servant at Elmer United Methodist Church and firmly believed in God's promises in Psalm 91. He graduated from the New Jersey State Military Academy as a Second Lieutenant and proudly served with the New Jersey National Guard and Army Reserve for 21 years from which he retired as a Captain in 1982. He owned and operated Walt's Garage on Park Avenue in Elmer until 2005 when the business was destroyed by fire. Walt loved tinkering with his Model T Ford and antique automobiles and was an avid gardener. He also drove a school bus for the Elmer Borough School District for 25 years, was a volunteer for the Elmer Fire Department for 50 years and was the President of the Exempt Firemen's Association in Elmer.

He is survived by his wife, Marcia Al-Jo Voeckler. They celebrated 57 years of marriage in October. Also surviving are Susan Voeckler Fuller and her husband Edward Fuller Jr., Edward Fuller III and Brooke Fuller and Edward Fuller IV and Ava Fuller, all of the Pittsgrove and Pilesgrove area, and Kristin Fuller Kortnick of Utah.

Services will be held on Tuesday, December 5, 2017 at the Elmer United Methodist Church, 21 S. Main Street, Elmer, NJ 08318 with a visitation from 10 to 11 AM followed by the funeral service at 11 AM. Interment will be at Chestnut Grove Cemetery in Elmer.
